



FAMILY FIREWORKS COVID POLICY

Per state and local COVID-19 guidelines, Newton Park is operating with limited spectators. To help our facility safely host our Family Fireworks event, Newton Park is allowing 200 families of 5 to attend this outdoor event.

SEATING PROCEDURE

- Families will be given an information sheet with policies and procedures before arriving at Newton Park.
 - Gates will open for seating at 9:15pm - 30 minutes before the event.
 - Newton Park staff will direct spectators where to sit and encourage proper social distancing on fields.
 - Spectators must leave through Newton Park's West Gate immediately after the conclusion of the Fireworks show.

PARKING LOT PROCEDURE

- Spectators will park in Newton Park's west parking lot off Mangus Rd. starting at 8:30pm.
 - Families will be given parking passes before the event.
 - Please maintain social distancing and refrain from gathering in large groups.
 - Park in Newton Park's West parking lot off Mangus.

OTHER INFORMATION

- Newton Park follows the current SJC Public Health order 4-2020 and requires a face covering be worn when 6 feet of physical distance cannot be maintained. We ask guests to follow this order for the health and safety of our community .
- Per St. Joseph's County health order, all persons in fully enclosed public spaces will be required to wear a mask.
- Our concession stand and bathrooms will be open - please go back to your families' location immediately after.
- Water fountains will not be available.
- Newton Park's Playground will be during events until further notice.
- If any spectators and/or staff members are not feeling well and/or exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms, Newton Park insists they stay home.
